


You must have heard of "Hansel and Gretel", "Rapunzel" and "Cinderella." Although they are popular children's stories now, they were actually written for adults. The Brothers Grimm were two brothers who collected and put together many fairy tales and legends from Germany in a book in 1817. Many of these stories are told to teach a lesson. "Hansel and Gretel" teaches us not to be greedy. "Rapunzel" encourages us that if we do not succeed at first, we should try again. "Cinderella" tells us that people are often not what they appear to be. As time passed, their stories changed a little and became the popular fairy tales that we know today. In modern times, most children grow up listening to the tales of the Brothers Grimm. Many kids learn <u>valuable</u> and useful life lessons from them.

Back in 2022, something interesting happened at the Colorado State Fair Arts Competition. An artwork called *Théâtre D'opéra Spatial*(太空歌劇院) was made by an AI tool named Midjourney. It won first place in the digital art category. Game designer Jason Allen worked for 80 hours on this piece and won \$300 for first place.

This win started a big debate. Many people felt it was not fair for Al-generated art to compete with art made by humans because Al didn't have the creativity and effort that human artists put in. On the other hand, others believe that Al can bring new and exciting ways to create art and can work with human creativity rather than taking humans' place.

This has made people think more about what art is, how creativity works, and how technology might change the future of art. It also raised questions about what makes art special and how we see art in a world that is getting more digital.
