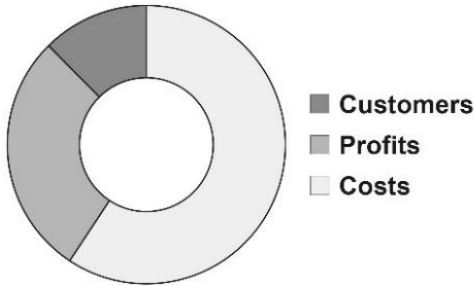
As you can see from the diagram, our restaurants became more and more popular over the past few months. Both the number of customers and our profits grew.
